

Talent development and retention initiative to assist unemployed and underemployed Portsmouth residents while building the pipeline of future workers.



Why now?

- Portsmouth has some of the highest income inequality in the region and unemployment inequality in pockets of underserved communities.
- Portsmouth organizations are experiencing a labor shortage: there aren't enough qualified people to fill the amount of jobs currently open.



Why this initiative?

- Portsmouth@Work is a reinforcement to Portsmouth Economic Development's ongoing work.
- We seek to lower the unemployment rates in our lowincome neighborhoods and to raise the overall income level in the city – person by person, job after job.

Overarching Goals

Form an environment of collaboration to strengthen Portsmouth's talent development and curate pathways for meaningful employment.

Build accessibility to workforce resources and services that prepare individuals for employment that increases quality of life factors.

- Grants participants access to industry-specific job boards & the inside tools, tricks, and resources connected to over 350,000 work from home job openings.

- Free self-paced, asynchronous training course
- Three programming options matched to different areas of digital literacy and skills:
 - DigitalLearn | Beginner and intermediate computer and internet skills
 - NORTHSTAR | Digital skills needed for job searching and beyond
 - Skills to Succeed | Assessment based program focused on learning skills to acquire a job and increase employability

SmartStart Entrepreneurship Training Program

- Multi-faceted program covering business ideation, marketing, selling, and more in three components:
 - Online Training
 - Business Plan
 - Pitch Your Business
- SmartStart connects participants with resources and mentorship on everything necessary to start, run and grow a business
- Participants receive a certificate of completion and a "loan ready" business plan upon completion.
